## DRAFT BUILDING BY-LAW

#### **OVERVIEW**

- The City of Yellowknife Building By-law applies to:
  - Design, construction, occupancy of all new buildings, and
  - Alteration, reconstruction, demolition, remodel, relocation and change of occupancy to all existing buildings
- The City's Building By-law adopts the National Building Code (NBC) and sets out elevated standards to meet our northern climate



### **BACKGROUND**

- By-law 3815 Adopted June 26, 1995
- Replaced by the Current Building By-law was adopted in 2008
- 2017 Council Motion directed Administration to repeal and replace



#### HIGHLIGHTS AND CHANGES

- Divided Draft By-law into two parts
  - Part 1 Administrative, and
  - Part 2 Local Construction Requirements
- Encourages reduced construction costs
  - Increasing options for some home sprinkler system design;
  - Increased clarity for using foundations stipulated in the NBC; and
  - Reduced the requirement to have an engineered foundation on accessory buildings



#### HIGHLIGHTS AND CHANGES CONT'D

- The changes will make the permitting process easier for stakeholders
- The administrative sections will be operationalized into the CityView during the upgrade
- No changes have been made to the energy efficiency section approved by Council in 2019
